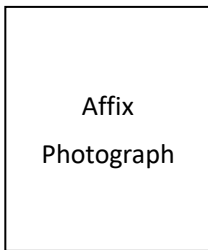

REQUEST TO PARENTS

Dear Parents

For the smooth functioning of the school, kindly take note of the following details:

1. Fill the first page of Students Personal Information.
2. Whenever there is a change in the Address, Phone Number or Mode of Transport, the concerned Class teacher or Coordinator should be informed.
3. Check your ward's Almanac and sign it daily.
4. Ensure that your ward comes to school on time.
5. Send your ward in proper school uniform along with his/her Identity Card.
6. Ensure that your ward's hair is neatly cut, his/ her nails are trimmed and he/she enters the school premises on or before time.
7. Ensure that your ward does his/ her homework neatly and regularly, unaided as far as possible.
8. Periodic Tests marks will be entered in the Almanac. Please sign regularly in the respective columns.
9. All the books and notebooks should be properly covered and labelled.
10. Children suffering from any infectious disease must not to be sent to school.
11. No child is allowed to leave the school premises during school hours without written permission.
12. Encourage your ward to take interest in co-curricular activities and sports.
13. If your ward is absent from the school, he must make up for all the work he/she has missed.
14. Ensure that your ward carries his books, pencil box and lunch box to school every day. **The practice of delivering any of the above said articles during the school hours is discouraged.**

SCHOOL RULES

1. GENERAL RULES:

1. Students are expected to maintain discipline and abide by the rules and regulations of the school.
2. Students are expected to arrive at the school five minutes before the bell rings.
3. Students should maintain personal hygiene and come neatly dressed in the school uniform. No student will be allowed to enter the school premises without proper uniform. Repeated defaulters will be sent back home.
4. Students should maintain cleanliness in and around the school premises. Use of bins is advisable.
5. Movement for activities and at dispersal should be done in silence and in an orderly fashion.
6. Students should maintain proper demeanor. (Bullying in any form-direct indirect, cyber bullying or using foul language are punishable offences and may even result in expulsion from the school)
7. The school reserves the right to suspend or to take strict disciplinary action against a student whose performance in studies is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
8. To avoid any mishap, the students are advised not to run in the corridors and on the stairs. They should walk in a queue silently through the corridors especially during the recess and at the dispersal time. They should ensure that they **keep to the left** while walking in the corridor and on the stairs.
9. Students should not carry mobile phones, tablets or other electronic gadgets to the school. **If found, the items will be confiscated by the school and will not be returned before final examinations.**
10. Children should not bring crackers and Holi colours to the school. Bursting of crackers and playing with Holi colours in the school premises is liable to lead to expulsion of a student from the school.
11. Parents and guardians are not allowed to visit their ward or teachers during the school hours without the permission of the Principal.
12. Students should not carry more than ₹100 in their pockets to school. Lending or borrowing money is not permitted. The school shall not be responsible for any loss.

13. It is mandatory for the students to maintain **minimum 75%** attendance in an academic year to make them eligible to sit in the final examination.
14. Students should not carry expensive articles (like watches) to school. The school shall not be responsible for any loss or damage.
15. No books (other than text books or library books), magazine or CDs should be brought to the school without the Principal's permission. Bringing objectionable literature to the school may lead to severe disciplinary action.
16. No student should indulge in any kind of bunking, rowdism and rude behaviour.

2. VISITING TIME FOR PARENTS:

The school would like parents to maintain a close rapport with the teachers teaching their wards in the school. Parent-Teacher Meetings/Interactions are organized periodically and regularly for this reason.

In order to meet the Coordinators / Teachers, please adhere to the following time schedule:

9:00 a.m. to 10: 00 a.m. (on all Saturdays except 3rd Saturday)

Meeting Time with Principal:

9:00 a.m. to 11: 00 a.m. (on all working days)

3. ABSENTEEISM:

1. Parents should intimate the school when the student is absent from the school stating the reason for absence through Whatsapp on the same day and by sending an application on the following day.
2. Students who have been sick should submit a medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner.
3. Absenteeism from the school may be allowed only with permission from the Principal.

4. Long absenteeism from the school without prior sanction of leave is not permitted. If a child remains absent from the school for five consecutive days without information, his / her name will be struck off from the rolls without any notice. Re-admission may be granted after payment of a fresh admission fee, only at the discretion of the Principal.

4. LATE ARRIVAL IN SCHOOL:

The school gate will be closed immediately after the arrival time of the students as mentioned in the Almanac. Late comers will not be allowed to enter the school once the gate is closed.

5. EXAMINATION:

A. Before commencement of the examination:

1. All dues must be cleared before the examination.
2. Students must come in proper uniform on the examination day.
3. Students must reach **5min** before the scheduled time. Late comers will not be given any extra time for the examination.

B. During the Examination:

1. Students will carry the stationery items in a transparent pouch and will not be allowed to borrow or lend anything (like pencil, pen, eraser etc.) during the examination.
2. Carrying calculators or scientific formulas in the examination hall is strictly prohibited.
3. No student will be allowed to submit the answer sheet before the scheduled time.
4. No student should indulge in any kind of unfair practices in the examination hall.

6. PUNISHMENTS:

1. Students who are into bullying and rowdy behaviour will be debarred from P.E periods. A warning letter will be issued for the first time to the offenders depending upon the severity of the offence.
2. If the same behaviour is repeated by the child despite counseling and warning then he/she will be suspended from the school.
3. For any damage to the school property, the child will have to pay a fine amounting to double the cost of the damage.
4. In case of misbehavior with the teachers / peer group, the student will be warned / suspended for the first offence. The punishment will be decided after proper investigation, depending on the severity of the misconduct.

7. FEE RULES

1. School fee is payable quarterly as per the schedule given below:

1 st Quarter	:	By 15 th April (April to June)
2 nd Quarter	:	By 15 th July (July to Sept.)
3 rd Quarter	:	By 15 th October (Oct. to Dec.)
4 th Quarter	:	By 15 th January (Jan. to Mar.)
2. Fee Deposit Timings : 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
3. After 15th, late fee of Rs. 100 per month will be charged up to the end of the fee month. In case 15th happens to be a public holiday, 16th will be the last day of the fee payment.
4. Cheques and Drafts will be accepted till 10th of every month.
5. Provision for online fee payment is also available.
6. Please retain the fee slip for the whole session.
7. If the dues are not paid by the end of the following month, the name of the student will be struck off from the rolls of the school.

8. SCHOOL'S LEARNING RESOURCE

The School Library is open to all the bonafide students of the school. All classes are provided with at least one library period per week. Students have to observe the following rules:

1. Books are issued for two weeks only. If a child fails to return the book on time, the borrowing facility shall be withdrawn for a week.
2. The reader shall not sub-lend the books issued by the library.
3. Students must satisfy themselves about the physical condition of the books before borrowing or else they shall be held responsible for any damage at the time of returning.
4. Reference books, magazines and periodical publications are to be read in the library only.
5. If the book is misplaced or damaged, the defaulter has to pay the cost of the book or replace the book.

9. TRIPS AND EXCURSIONS

Trips and Excursions are a part and parcel of the learning process of education. The school organises such trips regularly which are paid and optional apart from the regular fees.

10. HOUSE SYSTEM

There are Four Houses in the School –

- (a) **Aryabhata** (Green)
- (b) **Newton** (Red),
- (c) **Edison** (Yellow)
- (d) **Einstein** (Blue)

Every student from Class II to XII is allotted one of these houses. Each House consists of Captain, Vice-Captain, Sports Incharge, Cultural Incharge and Prefects. The House system and Prefectorial system, under the mentorship of teachers work very well and are conducive for all round development of the pupils. Inter House and Intra House activities are organised to ensure maximum participation and to encourage a healthy competitive spirit. Points are awarded to the students for their participation. At the end of the year, the house gaining the highest number of points is awarded the running trophy

11. SCHOOL TRANSPORT RULES

1. Students can avail the School Transport, subject to the availability of seats for any particular area. In case school transport is not available, the parents will have to make their own arrangements.
2. Bus facility once opted should be continued throughout the year.
3. All students using the school bus are expected to be at the bus stop at least 5 minutes before the arrival of the bus. They should be on the left side towards bus door.
4. Transport facility will not be provided for the extra classes.
5. Transport is a facility and does not entail any right to students and parent and any liability to school. If the bus is on duty or any other interruption like digging, construction, etc., the parent will have to make their own arrangements of dropping the students.
6. The bus will not wait for late comers.
7. The bus will stop only at the designated stops.
8. Fee amount is subject to change without any prior notice if there is a suitable reason e.g. hike in fuel, taxes, insurance etc.
9. Bus routes are fixed at the beginning of the academic session, please do not request for a change of route in the mid-session.
10. Students will not be allowed bus facility without “Bus Pass”. It should be kept along with the Identity Card.
11. If a bus user comes to the school on his/her own, she/he must immediately inform the transport incharge, bus attendance incharge, class teacher and at the reception.
12. The school is not responsible for any item left in school bus. The students are expected to keep all the belongings with them.
13. Parents are requested to pick their ward from the designated stop. In case the parent/guardian is not there to receive the ward, the driver is instructed to bring the child back to the school.
14. Students are to conduct themselves in the bus in such a way so as to not distract the bus driver and put everyone at risk.

14. WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION & PROMOTION

CLASSES – Nursery to III

The school follows a system of Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation throughout the year from Nursery to Class I where the cognitive as well as non-cognitive learning outcomes of the activities conducted are assessed. The children are awarded grades according to their performance which is assessed in **six cycles** during the academic session and participation in various activities. Assessment Schedule from Nursery to I will be duly sent to the parents at regular intervals of time during the academic year on a monthly basis.

CLASSES- IV to V

1. 60 Marks paper is conducted in the Annual Examination .
2. **33% passing marks:** A student must score at least 21 out of 60 to clear the exam for each subject.
3. 20 Marks are awarded for subject enrichment and notebook and 20 Marks are from periodic tests.

CLASSES- VI to X

1. In the Annual Examination of Classes VI to VIII 10%, 20% and 30% of syllabus of the First term will also be included respectively.
2. 100% syllabus will come in the Annual Examination in Classes IX and X.
3. Marks are awarded on the 9 point scale as it is done in Class –XII. Both grades and marks are awarded to the child in each subject.
4. 80 Marks paper is conducted in the Annual Examination.
5. **33% passing marks:** A student must score at least 27 out of 80 to clear the exam for each subject.
6. 20 Marks are awarded for Internal Assessments. Internal assessments consist of :

(i) Periodic Tests: 10 Marks of internal assessment are from periodic tests which includes pen & paper test (5 Marks) and multiple assessment (5 Marks). Total **three periodic tests** are conducted in an academic year for each subject. Average of the best two is counted in the internal assessment out of 10 marks.

Computer Application: Pre-Mid and Post-Mid tests will be completely practical based and marks awarded will be based on performance in the practical.

(ii) Portfolio: 5 marks of the internal assessment are for class work plus peer assessment, achievements of the student in the subject, reflections, narrations, journals etc.
